Awareness & Screening Update

Almost 2.5 lakh people die of kidney failure in India every year. It is the third largest killer after malignancy and heart disease. Along with helping our patients, spreading the word about kidney disease is equally important to TANKER. We have reached out to more than **1.87 lakh** people with the **1264 Awareness Programmes** we conducted at schools, colleges, law enforcement offices and public forums. We have also screened **35,154 individuals** for early detection of kidney disease through our **409 screening camps**.

TANKER UPDATE

We have completed **26 years** of service for the underprivileged with kidney ailments. With your help, we have meaningfully contributed to healthcare, research, training and advocacy connected to kidney disease. From June 1993 till **February 2020**, TANKER has provided **328,627 free and subsidized dialysis** for **1600 patients**. We have also given financial support of **Rs. 342 Lakhs to 3327 patients** as one-time contributions ranging from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 50,000/- for transplantation, medication, investigation and fistula surgery costs. We do **4854 dialyses** per month, of which **4626 are free of cost** with valuable help from the **Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS)**, **Greater Chennai Corporation** and other **valuable donors**. At present, we help **572 patients** in our units.
