Our Vision:

No patient should be denied treatment due to financial constraints and everyone has the right to good health and treatment.

Our Mission:

To detect, prevent and raise awareness on kidney ailments and to provide quality, affordable treatment to underprivileged people

TANKER (an acronym for Tamilnad Kidney Research) Foundation is a non-profit registered trust, founded on 30th June 1993 by Dr. Georgi Abraham Prof of Medicine and Consultant Nephrologist and likeminded people to reach out to under-privileged patients with kidney disease.

TANKER aims to provide health care and financial assistance to those who have kidney problems and do not have the wherewithal to seek medical attention.

TANKER cares for, the underprivileged, who suffer kidney problems of any kind, regardless of caste, creed, sex or religion.

TANKER along with our goodwill ambassador actor Suriya intends to set up subsidized dialysis units in other parts of Tamil Nadu.

TANKER with Actor Suriya's help aims to take kidney disease awareness programmes to schools and colleges all over Tamil Nadu.

Tanker Update:

We have completed 20 years of service for the underprivileged with kidney ailments. With the support of donors and well-wishers, we have meaningfully contributed to healthcare, research, training and advocacy connected to kidney disease. From June 1993 till March 2013, TANKER has provided 118,197 free and subsidized dialyses for 755 patients. We have also given financial support to the tune of Rs. 83.46 Lakhs to 1512 patients as one-time contributions ranging from Rs.5,000/- to Rs.50,000/- for transplantation, medication, investigation and fistula surgery costs.

Our three subsidized dialysis units have a total of 32 Dialysis Stations. The first is in Kilpauk (Chennai) and the other two are in Ambattur Rotary Hospital (Chennai) and TVS Hospital, Chokkikulam (Madurai). We do1511dialyses per month, of which 524 are free of cost. At present, we help 175 patients in our units. We also have dialysis facilities at PIMS, Pondicherry and G. B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair and hope to set up units in Coimbatore and Salem. In November 2009, we extended our support to HIV patients with kidney disease. Our HIV Dialysis Unit at Kilpauk provides dialysis to underprivileged HIV patients and is the first of its kind in India.

Along with helping our patients, spreading the word about kidney disease is equally important to TANKER. We have reached out to more than **77,000** people with the **386 Awareness Programmes**we conducted at schools, colleges, law enforcement offices and public forums. We have also screened **3500 individuals** for early detection of kidney disease through our **34 screening camps**. As the field of research in kidney diseases requires more attention and guidance in India, TANKER also gives awards for research in Nephrology and service to the tune of Rs. 5 lakhs every year.

Research & Service Awards Given Annually

Our 20th Annual Charity Awards Nite was held on Friday, 25th January 2013 at Hotel Savera, RK Salai, Chennai. For the past three years TANKER has used this special night as a platform to recognise and appreciate the efforts of professionals working tirelessly to improve the lives of people, especially the underprivileged with Chronic Kidney Disease.

TANKER presents research and service awards every year during the time of Republic EveNite. TANKER Charity Nite, does recognize and honour doctors for their services to people. On Jan 25th 2013 the following awards were presented.

Dialysis:

Brief description about the patient:

Ms. Sasikala, 17 years of age, stays with her parents in Chennai. She secured 68% marks in her plus two higher secondary examination last year. Now, she is doing her graduation. Her mother is a housewife and her father works in a private concern and earns Rs. 6,000 per month. Her brother is studying in college.

From birth Ms. Sasikala had Epispadias. . She had dysfunction of the urinary bladder due to disease of the central nervous system or peripheral nerves involved in the control of urination. She had renal failure due to frequent urinary infection. In 2011 she was diagnosed with renal failure. She had the symptoms of oedema and breathlessness. First she started dialysis in a private hospital.

The cost per dialysis in Private Hospitals ranges from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,500/- plus consumables. Later on,

her father could not afford the dialysis expenses. Her doctor referred her to TANKER. Now she is supported for her dialysis expenses by her father's employer. On the 7th of September 2011 Ms. Sasikala joined the Ambattur dialysis unit. She has registered for cadaver transplant in a private hospital because as she has neurogenic problems the doctors in Governmental hospital refused to register for cadaver transplant. Her health has improved greatly after taking regular dialysis. She is thankful to TANKER donors for helping her with her dialysis costs.

Medication:



Brief description about the patient:

Master. K. SelvaBalaji, aged 16 years, resides in Chennai. His father is a coolie and earns Rs.400/- per day. His mother is a tailor and earns Rs. 100/- per day. He has two school going sisters. Master. K. SelvaBalaji had renal problem from birth. He consulted a doctor in a Government hospital, Chennai. He had end stage kidney disease due to bilateral reflux nephropathy. A person with reflux nephropathy has abnormal, backward flow of urine from the bladder into the kidneys. The cause for reflux nephropathy is unknown. Normally, the ureter does not allow urine to flow from the bladder to the kidney. Patients with reflux nephropathy, the valves in the ureter do not function properly, and urine flows backward from the bladder, through the ureter, and into the kidneys. This can lead to kidney disease. In 2007, he underwent transplant at Apollo Hospital in Chennai on 14th June 2007. His father was the donor (Age 45). All

transplant patients are required to take anti-rejection medication for the rest of their lives. The monthly expenses for his medicine is nearly Rs.10,000/-. As he could not afford to meet his medical expense, he approached TANKER for medication., TANKER could provide the required medicines with the support of our generous donors.

Investigation:



Brief description about the patient:

Baby S. Kavya, aged 10 years, resides in Chennai. Her mother is a teacher and earns Rs. 2,000/- per month. Her father is not living with them. Baby S. Kavya has renal problem from birth. One kidney is in perfect condition another one is damaged. In 2013, she had severe stomach pain and was on treatment at Government General Hospital at Chennai. Her mother approached us for financial assistance for **Plain CT KUB, DTPA and DMSA Scan** which was done with the support of TANKER donors.


Fistula Surgery:



Brief description about the patient:

Mrs. Vasantha aged 61 years. She is a home maker. Her husband is working as a security in private concern and earns Rs. 5,000/- per month. They have a married daughter. In 2011, she had a symptom of less urine output and was on a medication for the past two years. In 2013, she consulted a doctor in a private hospital. After investigation the report showed that creatinine level is highand was diagnosed as renal failure. She was advised for dialysis and has approached us for financial assistance for her Fistula Surgery which was done with help from TANKER donors.

EPO Injection:



Brief description about the patient:

Mr. N. Viswanathan, aged 53 years, resides in Chennai. He is working as a part time accountant. His wife is a home maker. He has a son who is a B.Tech student. In 2011, he had a problem of breathless. He consulted a doctor in a private hospital. After investigation the report showed he had renal failure and was advised for Peritoneal dialysis (CAPD). The doctor advised him to take EPO injection (2000 K) weekly twice. He has approached us for financial assistance for EPO Injection which was done with help from TANKER donors.
