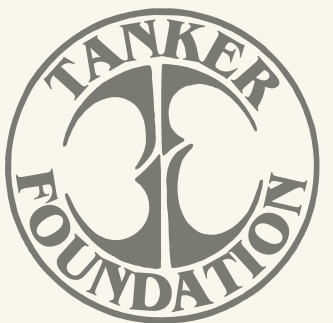

OUR MISSION:

To detect, prevent and raise awareness on kidney ailments and to provide quality, affordable treatment to underprivileged people

TANKER (an acronym for Tamilnad Kidney Research) Foundation is a non-profit registered trust, founded on 30th June 1993 by Dr.Georgi Abraham Prof. of Medicine and Consultant Nephrologist and likeminded people to reach out to under-privileged patients with kidney disease.

TANKER aims to provide health care and financial assistance to those who have kidney problems and do not have the wherewithal to seek medical attention.

TANKER cares for the underprivileged, who suffer kidney problems of any kind, regardless of caste, creed, sex or religion.

TANKER along with our goodwill ambassador actor Suriya intends to set up subsidized dialysis units in other parts of Tamil Nadu.

TANKER with Actor Suriya's help aims to take kidney disease awareness programmes to schools and colleges all over Tamil Nadu.



TANKER UPDATE:

We have completed 21 years of service for the underprivileged with kidney ailments. With your help, we have meaningfully contributed to healthcare, research, training and advocacy connected to kidney disease. From June 1993 till March this year, TANKER has provided 157,179 free and subsidized dialysis for 855 patients. We have also given financial support of Rs. 105 Lakhs to 2145 patients as one-time contributions ranging from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 50,000/- for transplantation, medication, investigation and fistula surgery costs.

Our four subsidized dialysis units have a total of 42 Dialysis Stations. Our four units are in Ambattur Rotary Hospital (Chennai), TVS Hospital, Chokkikulam (Madurai), RVS Hospital, Sulur, Coimbatore and in Corporation P.H.C, Nungambakkam, Chennai. We do 1,938 dialyses per month, of which 1,555 are free of cost with valuable help from the Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) and other donors. At present, we help 224 patients in our units. We also have a dialysis facility at PIMS, Pondicherry and our current plan is to set up a unit in Imphal (Manipur). In November 2009, we started our HIV Dialysis Unit providing dialysis to underprivileged HIV patients. This is the first of its kind in India. We also have a sister organization, Kerala Kidney Research Foundation, which provides free and subsidized dialysis at Thiruvella Medical Mission, SH Hospital, Kottayam and PVS Hospital, Kochi(Kerala).

Along with helping our patients, spreading the word about kidney disease is equally important to TANKER. We have reached out to more than 1.1 lakh people with the 663 Awareness Programmes we conducted at schools, colleges, law enforcement offices and public forums. We have also screened 11,000 individuals for early detection of kidney disease through our 117 screening camps. As the field of research in kidney diseases requires more attention and guidance in India, TANKER also gives awards for research in Nephrology and Service to the tune of Rs. 5 lakhs every year.

History of some patients supported by TANKER

Dialysis:



Mrs. Manimegalai of 63 years resides at Coimbatore. She is a retired teacher. Her husband is supporting her with limited resources from agriculture income. They have a son and a daughter who are studying.

Brief description about the patient:
Mr. Raja aged 25 years resides in Coimbatore. He is unable to work due to his illness.

His mother is a home maker. His father is a weaver and earns Rs. 5,000/- per month. He has a married brother and sister.

In 2012 he was diagnosed with renal failure due to uncontrolled blood pressure. He had giddiness and vomiting as the symptoms of renal failure. Initially he looked after his dialysis cost from his own earning. The cost per dialysis in private hospitals ranges from Rs. 2,000/- to Rs. 3,000/- plus consumables. Later on, he could not afford his dialysis expenses. He knows TANKER Foundation through our patient Mr.Sathish Kumar and joined our Coimbatore Subsidized Dialysis unit on 22nd July 2015.

Medication:



Brief description about the patient:

Mr. Raghunath is 24 years, resides in Chennai. He was a B. Tech student but he discontinued his studies due to his illness. His father is Government employee and earns Rs. 10,000/- per month. His mother is a home maker. He has two school going younger sisters. In 2006, he had been affected by Chikunguniya fever. He

was admitted in a private hospital. After investigation the report showed he had renal failure also. Mr. B. Raghunath had heart attack in 2010. He was on dialysis for eight years. He underwent transplant at a private hospital in Chennai on 05th September 2012. His father was the donor. He is unable to purchase post-transplant medicine and has approached us for financial assistance. All transplant patients are required to take anti-rejection medication for the rest of their lives. The monthly expenses for his medicine is nearly Rs. 10,000/-. As he could not afford to meet his medical expense, he approached TANKER for medication. TANKER could provide the required medicines with the support of our donors.

Transplantation:



Mr.Lakshmanan aged 32 years single, resides in Chennai. He is unable to work because of his illness. His father is an aged person and mother is a home maker. He has a brother. He gets support from his brother. In 2014 he had a problem of high BP. After investigation the report showed he had renal failure and was advised for transplant. He was shifted to Government Stanley hospital, Chennai. He underwent transplant on 26th March 2015 in Stanley Hospital, Chennai. His mother was the donor (Age 50). He has approached us for financial assistance for his transplantation. TANKER provided with the required items for surgery. He is thankful to

TANKER for the support.

Investigation:



Mrs.Suriyakala aged 23 years resides in Chennai. She is a home maker. Her husband is working in a private concern and earns Rs. 10,000/- per month. In 2013 she was treated for the problem high BP. After investigation the report showed she had renal failure. She underwent transplant on 04th November 2013 in Government Stanley hospital, Chennai. Her mother was the donor. She approached us for financial assistance for "Tacrolimus Level" test. TANKER supported her to carry out the lab investigation with the support of TANKER donors.

Fistula:

Mr. Pradeep, aged 40, resides in Chennai. He is a driver and earns Rs.2,500/- per month. He has 8 year old daughter. His wife is a home maker.



Mr. Pradeep had diabetes and hypertension and was on insulin and medication for diabetes for about 25 years. In 2009, he was diagnosed with renal failure due to uncontrolled blood pressure. He was advised for dialysis. Initially he managed the dialysis costs with his earnings. The cost per dialysis in private hospitals ranges from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 2,500/- plus consumables. Later on, he could not afford his dialysis expenses as he could not go to work regularly due to his illness. He was referred to TANKER Foundation by his friend. He joined our Ambattur Subsidized Dialysis unit on 27th Jan' 2010. Last month, his fistula failed. A fistula needs to be done for a patient to have dialysis. This is where a vein and an artery are joined at the wrist to give proper access for dialysis.

The patient underwent surgical procedure for AV Fistula. TANKER Foundation helped him for the surgery costs. He is extremely thankful to TANKER for helping him for his surgery costs.

EPO Injection

Brief description about the patient: Mr.Sekar aged 27 years resides in Chennai. He is unable to work due to his illness. His father is no more. His mother is a home maker. He has a mentally challenged sister. In 2012 he had symptoms of giddiness and high BP. He consulted a doctor in a government hospital. After investigation the report showed he had renal failure and he was advised to undergo dialysis. The doctor advised him to take an EPO injection [4000 k] twice a week. He is now taking free dialysis in Lions Haemodialysis Centre, Chrompet. The doctor advised him to take EPO injection [4000 k] twice a week. He has approached us for financial assistance for EPO Injection which was done with help from TANKER donors.
